STEM Literacy Teacher

Under the direction of the Site Coordinator and the Directors of Instruction the Teacher Tutors work with small groups of elementary students in planning and implementing instruction for STEM intervention. Teachers will conduct DIBELS Next assessments. Scholars Unlimited programs are located in elementary schools throughout Denver, within Denver Public Schools.

Job requirements

- Deliver literacy instruction to enhance the STEM units of study by building concepts and vocabulary
- Work with additional site staff such as the STEM Associate
- Deliver curriculum provided by Scholars Unlimited
- Communicate with Scholars Unlimited Site Coordinator and Scholars Unlimited staff
- Complete hiring paperwork, orientation and training are requirements for employment
